## **LONDON CAB-DRIVERS**

London cab-drivers are very proud of their profession. It isn't easy to become a qualified cab driver in London. You have to pass a series of tests called "The Knowledge" before you can get a cab-driver's license in this famous city.

In order to pass the tests, you have to memorize the names and locations of 25,000 streets I and around central London. Drivers have to know where all the places, like hospitals theatres, hotels and train stations are located. A good driver also needs to know the fastest way to get from one place to another in this big city.

Candidates for a cab-driver's license drive around London for a few hours every day to prepare themselves for the tests. They often ride a motorbike, learning the many streets and routes as they ride. It can take a whole year to prepare for "The Knowledge".
